- ⁱⁱ **Retention Rates** - A measure of the rate at which students persist in their educational program at an institution, expressed as a percentage. Students remain in a cohort until completion of their program.
- ⁱⁱⁱ **Completion Rates** - (*Traditional UG – Cohort 2013, Degree Completion – Cohort 2016, Graduate – Cohort 2016*) A measure of the number of students completing their program within 150% of the normal time to complete. A student should be counted as completing “on time” if the student graduates within 150% of the program.
- ^{iv} **Alumni Survey** – The Baccalaureate Survey (One Year Out) was administered in 2019. The Master’s Alumni Survey was administered in 2017 and will be updated every two – three years. The Associate’s and Degree Completion Alumni Survey will be administered in Spring 2020. The Job Placement Outcomes and Christian Ministry Outcomes are taken from the Alumni Surveys.
- ^v **BS Bible** – First-time Cairn students in the 2013 cohort who have declared a major within the School of Divinity. This excludes non-degree seeking students, First Year Programs and dual-degree programs that include a major outside the School of Divinity.
- ^{vi} **Graduate Completion Rates** - 61% of Divinity Graduate Students that did not complete were part-time students. 11% are currently enrolled.
